“What’s special about this program is that it gives everyone in the wine industry a fun and easy way to participate in saving the life of a pet. Each year, as more wineries and wine industry companies send us photos of their pets, Cork Supply’s donation to local pet rescue operations on behalf of the wine industry grows,” said Herwatt. Cork Supply welcomes additional donations from wineries and wine industry companies who wish to contribute further to this cause.
